Enrollment and Session Information

- Selection of students for the program will be based on age. Older students will have first choice.
- High school dropouts are not eligible to enroll in Driver Education.
- Classroom instruction for **Spring Session 1** will begin February 4th or 5th and end March 13th.
- Classroom instruction for **Spring Session 2** will begin March 25th or 26th and end May 6th or 7th.
- The course will be taught two hours each day, three days per week, immediately after school is dismissed. Please review the tables below for the days and times classes will be taught at your assigned school.

- A roster of students scheduled for the classroom phase will be posted in each middle and high school before the scheduled class is to begin. This information will also be available on the Cumberland County Schools' website at www.ccs.k12.nc.us. From the CCS' homepage, select the link for "students," and then the link "Driver's Education Information." Students will also receive a computerized phone message about a week before the class begins.
- A fee of \$65.00 or a reduced fee of \$32.50 will be collected from each student on the first day of class. The fee must be in the form of a money order made payable to Cumberland County Schools. **(Personal checks will not be accepted).** **Please DO NOT BRING CASH for payment. This fee will be collected by the driver education teacher on the first day of class.** If the student does not bring the required fee on the first day of class, he/she will not be admitted to class. There are no exceptions or refunds!
 In order to qualify for the reduced fee, **you must be enrolled in the free-and-reduced meal program with the Cumberland County Schools' Child Nutrition Services (CNS).** The student must bring a Letter of Approval from CNS, along with the fee of \$32.50. Any student who does not have the Letter of Approval will be issued a "Student Eligibility Form" which must be completed by a parent/guardian and returned to the Driver Education Instructor.
- **It shall be the responsibility of parents to ensure that students are picked up PROMPTLY after class is dismissed.**
- **Students are expected to attend all class sessions.** There are no excused or unexcused absences in Driver Education.
- **Upon completion of the 30 hours classroom requirement,** students will be scheduled to complete their 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction. Older students will have first priority. **Students will be notified by telephone when they are assigned to do their behind-the-wheel instruction.**
- Students who are enrolled in **Spring Session 1** will be driven no later than the last day of school (May 24, 2019). Students who are enrolled in **Spring Session 2** will drive during the summer (June & July). No absences are allowed for behind-the-wheel instruction. Transportation to and from school for this phase must be provided by the parent.
