Enrollment

- Students who are regularly enrolled at Cumberland Polytechnic High School **who have a date of birth on or before August 1, 2004**, are eligible to enroll. North Carolina Law states that students who are 18 years old or older are not required to take Driver Education. Students who are 18 years of age or older may go to NCDMV and apply for a learner's permit or license.
- There must be sufficient enrollment for this course to be offered! (not less than 25 students)
- A fee of \$65.00 or a reduced fee of \$32.50 shall be collected from each student. The fee must be in the form of a money order made payable to Cumberland County Schools. **(Personal checks will not be accepted)**. **Please No Cash! This fee will be collected by the driver education teacher on the first day of class.** There are no exceptions or refunds! If the student does not bring the required fee on the first day of class, he/she will not be admitted to class.

In order to qualify for the reduced fee, you must be enrolled in the free-and-reduced meal program with the Cumberland County Schools' Child Nutrition Services. The student must bring a Letter of Approval from Child Nutrition along with the fee of \$32.50. Any student who does not have the Letter of Approval will be issued a "Student Eligibility" form which must be completed by a parent/guardian and returned to the Driver Education Instructor.

- A roster of students scheduled for the 30 hours of classroom will be posted at Cumberland Polytechnic High School before the scheduled class is to begin. This information will also be available on the Cumberland County Schools' web site at www.ccs.k12.nc.us. Click on the word students then click on Driver Education. Students will also receive a computerized phone message concerning the upcoming class before the class begins.
- Class will begin Monday, March 18th and will conclude Thursday, April 11th! Classes will be held at Cumberland Polytechnic High School on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday after school from 2:40 until 4:40 p.m.
- **Students are expected to attend all class sessions.** There are no excused or unexcused absences in Driver Education.
- It shall be the responsibility of parents to ensure that the student is picked up **PROMPTLY** after class is dismissed. **If you are late in picking up your student you run the risk of them being dropped from the course.**
- Upon completion of the 30 hours classroom instruction, students will be scheduled to complete their 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction after school and/or on Saturdays. Older students will have first priority. No absences are allowed for behind-the-wheel instruction. **Students will be notified by telephone when they are assigned to do their behind-the-wheel instruction.** Transportation to and from school for this phase must be provided by the parent.
